The International Lecithin and Phospholipid Society (ILPS) and Ghent University organize the 3rd ILPS Lecithin Short Course in University Conference Centre "Het Pand", Ghent, Belgium on 10 – 11 June 2010.

Ten world class instructors will teach in six sessions the inn's and out's of lecithins and phospholipids. Topics are focused on:

- Technological functions of Soy, Sunflower and Rapeseed lecithin
- Nutrition related properties of Egg, Marine, Milk and Soy Phospholipids
- Preparation and characterization of emulsions and liposomal dispersions.

The SC will be an excellent training and networking platform for all scientists and industrial professionals, working with lecithin and phospholipids in very diverse fields of application ranging from food and feed to pharmacy and medicine.

The call for posters on related topics is open for PhD and MSc students. The winning poster will receive the ILPS Best Poster Award. Participation can be rewarded with ECTS points.

At the end of the SC participants will visit the newly opened UGent Cocoa Laboratory, optionally followed by a sight seeing tour through the historic Ghent centre.
